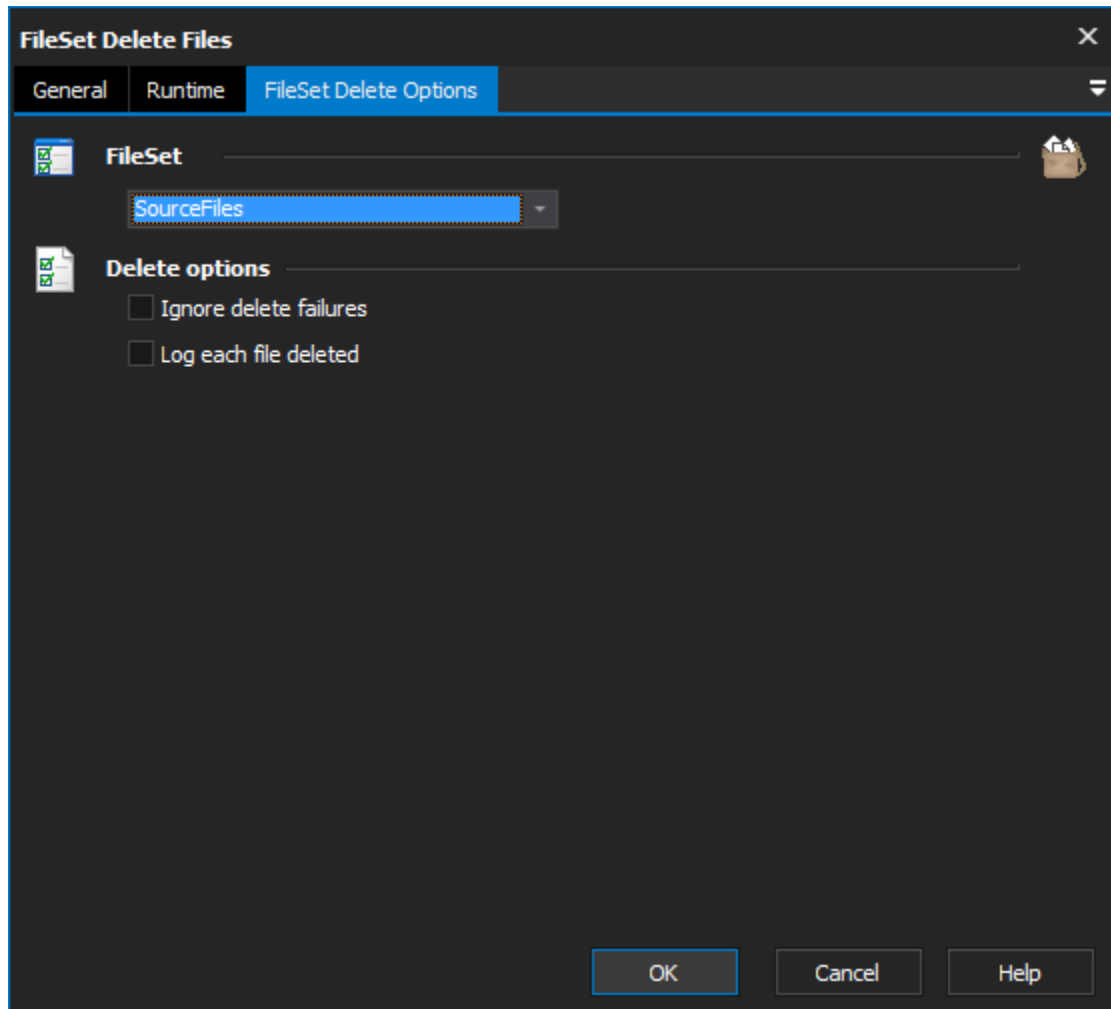


# FileSet Delete Files Action
