


Telnet Client Action

This action provides a simple scriptable Telnet client.

The script items allow you to wait for a string and (optionally) respond with a string.

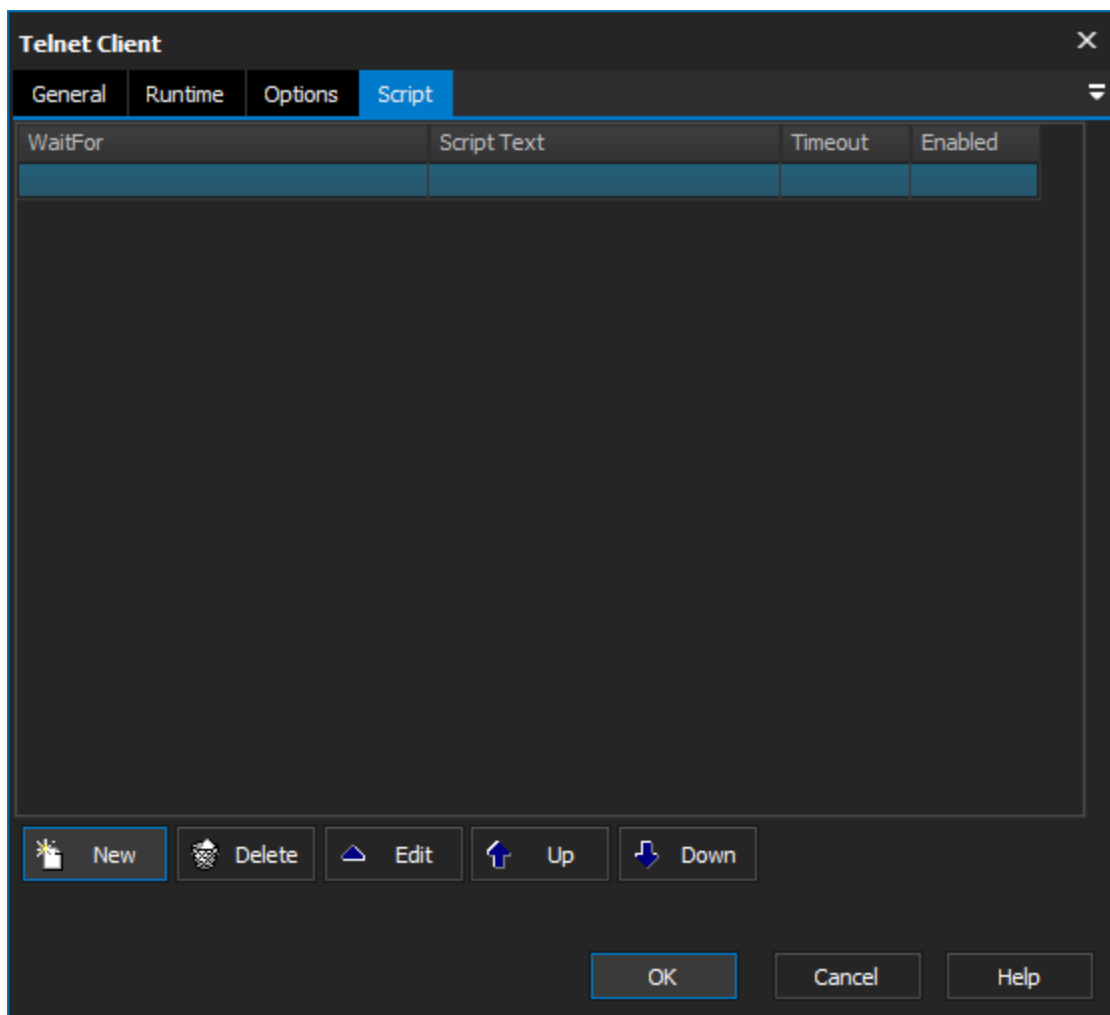
