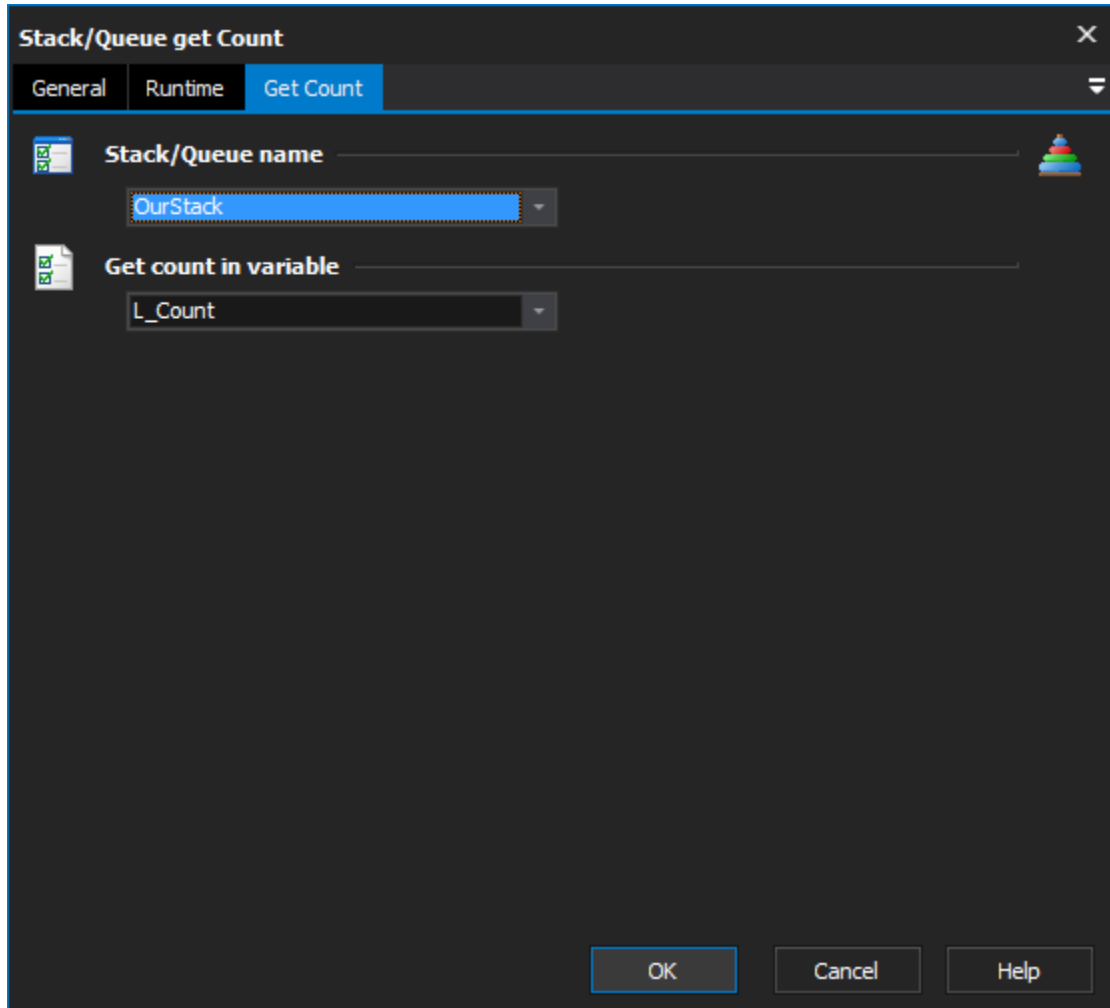


Stack or Queue Get Count Action
