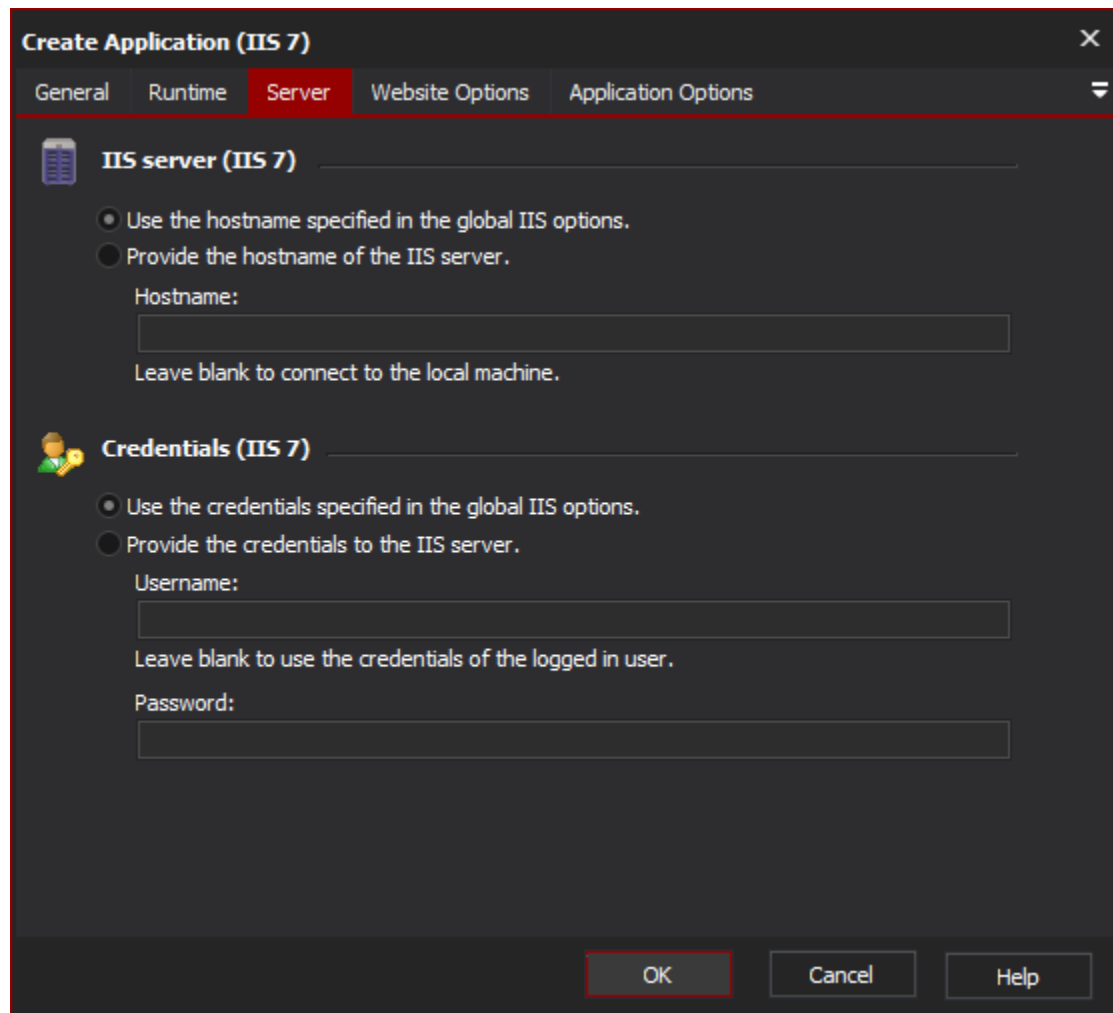


Create Application Action - [IIS 7]
