To determine if a host exists:

1. Specify the name of the host that you want to check.
2. Choose a DNS server to query:
 - a. Default Server - selecting this option will query the server which is defined as the current machine's DNS server.
 - b. Specific Server - specify the DNS server to query.
3. Set the options:
 - a. Fail if Host cannot be found- The action will fail if the host is not found. If not selected, the action will pass regardless (a warning will be raised if the host is not found).
 - b. Timeout - Specify the timeout value at which point the query will be abandoned if the host has not been found.
